### Purpose

This patch release brings v2.0.0 of the application into compliance with third-party software license requirements. It includes the fixes in v2.0.0 SP 1, v2.0.0 SP 2, and v2.0.0 SP 3, and it replaces those releases, which are no longer available.

The purpose of this patch release is strictly to provide an upgrade path for customers currently running v1.1.x. This patch cannot be installed on v2.0.0 systems. We strongly encourage customers already running an earlier release of v2.0.0 to upgrade to the current patch release of v2.3.0.

Systems must have Polycom DMA 7000 version 1.1, 1.1.1, or 1.1.1 SP2 installed prior to applying this patch. No other prerequisites exist.
