The RealPresence Video DualManager 400 system uses the CentOS operating system. CentOS is an enterprise-class Linux operating system that contains hundreds of open-source components. For more information about CentOS, visit <http://www.centos.org/>.

The RealPresence Video DualManager 400 system includes instances of two of the major Polycom RealPresence Platform management applications on a single hardware host. The two components it includes are:

- An instance of the Polycom RealPresence Resource Manager system
- An instance of the Polycom RealPresence DMA system
