

Microbrowser Enhancements in Polycom® UC Software 4.0.0

This engineering advisory summarizes new enhancements to the microbrowser feature available with Polycom® UC Software 4.0.0.

This engineering advisory applies to Polycom phone users and administrators who are using or developing microbrowser applications on phones that support UC Software 4.0.0: Polycom® SoundPoint® IP 321, 331, 335, 450, 550, 560, 650, and 670 desktop phones.

Microbrowser Enhancements in UC Software 4.0.0

UC Software 4.0.0 incorporates a range of enhancements to the microbrowser's capabilities. These enhancements are available both to phone users and administrators.

Enhancements for Users

The new enhancements make it easier for you to navigate microbrowser applications and access phone menus. The enhancements will enable you to:

- Select double-digit line entries from a numbered list using the dial pad. For example, pressing 1 and 2 in succession will enable you to select entry 12 in a list.

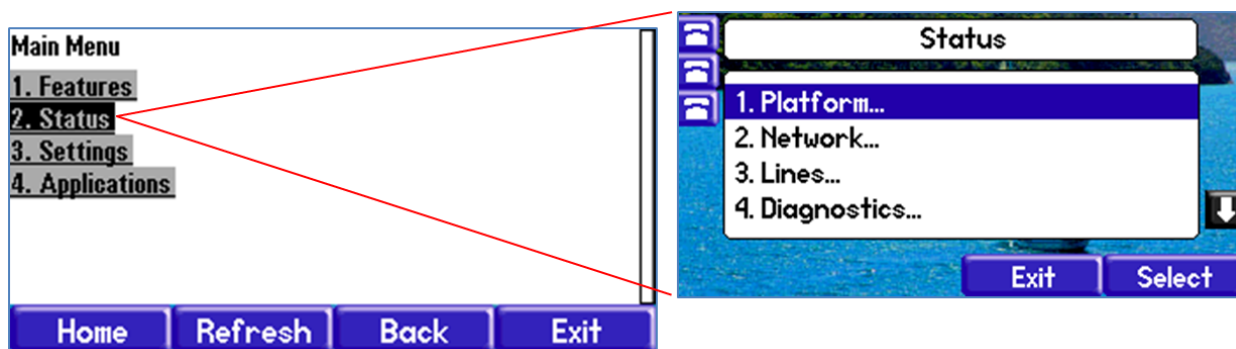
In addition, UC Software 4.0.0 enhancements have improved the functionality of media player applications, for example, the visual voicemail application. The media player enhancements will enable you to:

- Download a .wav file from a list of audio files.
- Play voicemails through the speakerphone, handset, or headset. By default, phones will play voicemail audio through the speakerphone. If you lift the handset before or during a voicemail, the audio will play through the handset. Pressing the *Headset* or *Speakerphone* key on the phone's interface will play voicemail audio through the respective option.
- Pause, resume, or close a .wav file while it's playing.

Enhancements for Developers

Enhancements to the microbrowser feature in UC Software 4.0.0 give developers greater flexibility regarding field entries, menu linking, and custom soft keys when creating microbrowser applications. As a developer, these enhancements enable you to:

- Set restrictions for different character types in available user fields. For example, you can provide users the ability to enter only numeric characters in certain fields.
- Create a hyperlink to the *Status* menu, as shown in the following illustration.



- Display custom soft keys while users are editing fields. For example, where in previous versions users exited a field to submit information, you can enable a custom *Submit* soft key to display that users can press to instantly submit information.
